3. Regular Reviews

Your agent should check in with you at least once or twice a

year to make sure all your information is up-to-date, and check to see if your requirements have changed. For instance, maybe you got married and want to consider prenatal insurance; or perhaps you moved into a new house and want to make sure your property is insured against fires or a break-in. These circumstances may require an add-on or a different policy to help you stay covered in the case of unexpected events or emergencies.

4. Be Available When You Need Them

This is the most crucial thing that your insurance agent must be able to do for you. They should be able to provide directions on what to do if you need to get admitted into a hospital and your medical card has gone missing; or in the case that you have a traffic accident and need to file a claim. They should always respond to all your queries in a timely manner with a concise explanation – without making you feel confused or overwhelmed.
